

Frequently Asked Questions

How does the program work?*

You must work five days a week at an assigned job site. After serving 50% of your sentence you may elect to work a minimum of two days if employment is established.

How much does it cost?

There is a \$90 administrative fee.

What are the requirements?

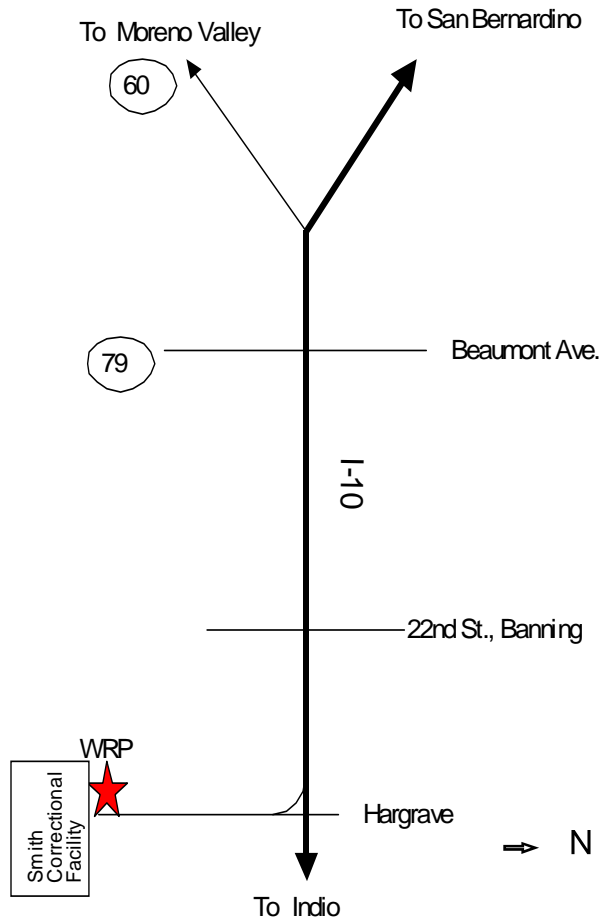
- Work a minimum of 8 hours a day.
- Perform manual labor (landscaping, filing, community beautification etc.)
- Promise to appear at an assigned job site.

How can I apply?

Introduction

Purpose:

The Riverside County Sheriff's Department was given the authorization by the Board of Supervisors to establish a Work Release Program (WRP) pursuant to Penal Code 4024.2. The program is a cost effective alternative for minimum security, low-risk, non violent offenders.

Advantages:

Participating offenders can:

- Complete sentence
- Gain employment
- Attend school
- Live at home
- Receive own medical care
- Meet child care needs
- Attend Counseling

Application Process

If you feel you qualify for the program, submit to the Housing Deputy the green application. A WRF Deputy will interview you. The information on the attached green application will be verified. It will be returned to you to let you know if your application has been accepted or denied.

If you have been accepted

Required Items:

- Ensure that you are able to reside at the address you provided
- Pay \$90 administrative fee (this fee may be waived by the WRF supervisor)

****You must have basic telephone service***

****You must have reliable transportation.***

****You must report to your probation officer upon your release***

****You must report to the WRP Office as directed. _____ @ _____ hours***

****You must maintain communication with the WRP Coordinator.***

Eligibility

Eligible offenders:

- Live in Riverside County or within a reasonable distance.
- Have a working telephone
- Able to pay the initial administrative fee.
- Agree to adhere to the rules, regulations, and requirements of the W.R.P.

Failure to comply:

Failure to comply with the rules/regulations of the W.R.P. will result in immediate termination from the program and you will be returned to custody to complete the remainder of your time.

You are not eligible if:

- You cannot cooperate due to mental conditions
- You have behavior problems such as: excessive failure to appear violations, or have been previously terminated from Full-Time WRP for non-compliance.
- You have violent charges
- You previously failed the Full-Time work release program
