

Frequently Asked Questions

How does the program work?*

You must work a minimum of two days at an assigned job site until your sentence is complete.

How much does it cost?

There is a \$90 administrative fee.

What are the requirements?

- Work a minimum of 8 hours a day.
- Perform manual labor (landscaping, filing, community beautification etc.)
- Sign a Promise to appear

What should I do if I can not appear at my assigned job site?

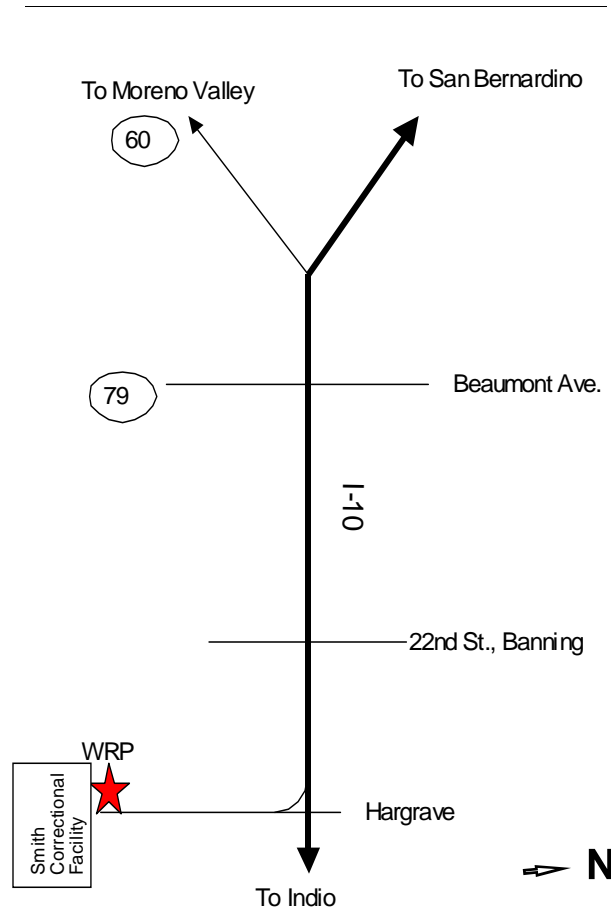
- Report to the Work Release Office for re assignment by the second Wednesday after you failed to appear.
- Pay a \$90 administrative fee.
- If you do not report to the Work Release Office as stated above, you will be required to appear before the magistrate for re-instatement.

Are there any other options other than work release?

Yes, you may elect to enroll in the Secured Electronic Monitoring Program. For more information call 1-800-501-0311.

Introduction

The County Board of Supervisors authorized the Riverside County Sheriff's Department to establish a Work Release Program (WRP) under the authority of section 4024.2 of the California Penal Code.

Intent:

An alternative sentencing program in lieu of jail time.

Advantages:

Participating offenders can:

- Complete sentence while not in custody
- Maintain employment
- Attend school
- Live at home
- Attend court mandated classes

Program Requirements

- You must report to the work release office between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on the date the court ordered you to report.
- You must have a valid government issued photo identification card.
- You must pay a \$90 administrative fee. (You may pay with cash, credit card, debit card, or U.S. Postal Money Order.)
- You must be able to work between 8-10 hours a day. Failure to do so will result in no credit and a \$90 administrative fee to reinstate.
- You must be able to work a minimum of two days a week at an assigned job site.
- You must be able to perform manual labor.
- You must sign a promise to appear.
- You must be able to provide reliable transportation to the job site.
- You must abide by all work release and job site rules and regulations.

Failure to comply:

Failure to comply with the rules/regulations of the Work Release Program shall result in immediate termination from the program

Failure to Appear:

You are considered a Failure to Appear (FTA) if you do not show up at the job site or you are late.

You are not allowed to return to the job site without a reinstatement form or promise to appear contract.

You can reinstate yourself onto the program only two times. Upon receiving your third FTA, you must report to the court for reinstatement.

Request to Change Days/Job Site:

You may report to the work release office Monday through Friday between 9 a. m. and 4 p.m.

You are allowed to change your work days **only** one time. Thereafter, a \$90 administrative fee may be associated.

There is a \$90 administrative fee charged to change assigned job sites.

(The Work Release Deputies will determine the assigned job site)
